Membership of the Association is open to-

- Wildlife rehabilitators and wildlife volunteers resident in Western Australia who can demonstrate that they have been active in the field of wildlife rehabilitation on a voluntary basis for a period of at least twelve months
- Animal health professionals and tertiary students resident in Western Australia and studying towards a qualification in the animal health profession
- Incorporated bodies whose objects and activities are considered to be congruent with and not detrimental to the objects and activities of the Association.

Note: A 30 day membership-qualifying period applies to new applicants
